For personal reflection, or as discussion starters

- 4. Why can God use my words, even when I feel like I say the wrong thing? Can I be happy about being a poor witness?
- 5. Why is Jesus' question, "Who do you say that I am?" (Mark 8:29) so important? List some good answers, then pick the best one.
- 6. Why is happiness such a fleeting experience? Why is Joy better than happiness? Does God want me to be happy, and if He does, why do things happen that make me unhappy?
- 7. List some things to do this week to increase pleasure for yourself and for others.
